They must demonstrate proficiency in verbal and written communication in English, as well as very good presentation skills. In addition, the selected candidates will be well organised and have excellent management and supervisory skills. They will be required to perform under pressure and on their own initiative, and must be prepared to travel abroad on project meetings and staff exchanges. Experience in European projects and project management will be considered an asset.

This call is open to all EU Nationals and other persons having a valid permit to live and work in Malta. Interviews with interested persons not currently residing in Malta will be carried out via phone or conference call. If an overseas candidate is successful, the GDA will not cover any costs of travel to Malta, airport transfers, nor any relocation costs of any kind. The selected candidates will be offered a 3-year definite contract on a part-time or full-time basis, which may be extended based on performance and the availability of EU projects. Flexible working hours can be agreed upon, as and when the successful management and execution of the projects so require and so permit. Remuneration is negotiable and commensurate with the successful candidate's qualification and experience.
